Suffolk Coastal Torpedoes WPC School Liaison Officer ~ what we would like to happen!

Suffolk Coastal Torpedoes WPC will actively seek new opportunities to work with local primary and secondary schools to ensure the club can meet the needs of the local community.

The School Liaison Officer will aim to meet these needs by managing the following and reporting to the committee on a monthly basis what links have been established.

- **Sourcing, establishing and developing sustainable links with local schools** ~ *by communicating with the surrounding Primary schools for learning & developing water polo skills opportunities and with the Secondary (private & public) Schools to provide a competitive environment together with providing access to GCSE/A Level PE work studies.*
- **Managing and promoting club links with identified schools** ~ *keep a record of schools contacted and outcomes.*
- **Liaising with; Head School Teacher, Club Coach and Teaching Co-ordinator to organise taster/come and try sessions** ~ *once the schools have bought into the links the Liaison Officer will feedback to the schools the pupils progress, liaise with the coaches and keep the necessary documentation to promote best practise for future links.*
- **Inviting pupils to attend specific taster/come and try sessions** ~ *with the schools consent and in liaison with the Head Coach.*
- **Communicating the delivery of taster sessions to schools** ~ *via school newsletters, emails or visits.*
- **Liaising with local Schools, Sports Development Officer & Schools Sports Coordinators** ~ *working with them to develop a link between the Water Polo club and training for schools without a training facility.*
- **Attending local Water Polo Festivals** ~ *links and information sourcing.*
- **Distributing information as required to Schools** ~ *invitations to taster days etc.*
