Economically Disadvantaged Players Policy

Suffolk Coastal Torpedoes Water Polo Club wishes to promote an environment of equality irrelevant of financial status.

Where a water polo player or applicant to be a player of the Club is deemed to be someone who may be categorised as being Economically Disadvantaged due to their personal circumstances, then the Suffolk Coastal Torpedoes Committee, on application from such a person, may decide to waive part or all of any payments which would become due from such person's membership of the Club.

Any applicant would, within reason, be expected to provide evidence of hardship or economic disadvantage and would normally be expected to be eligible for free school meals and be able to provide a copy of this entitlement. Any such request will be considered at the next available committee meeting provided that the request is reasonable, and evidenced.

Each application would be judged on its own merits and treated in the strictest confidence.

The decision of the committee will be conveyed to the Parent/carer of the player as soon as possible, by letter.

The player's parents/carers should keep the committee informed of their personal circumstances as they change.

Suffolk Coastal Torpedoes committee will review all cases where financial support is being given, quarterly, as a matter of course.
